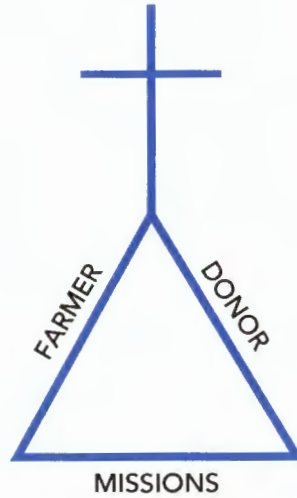

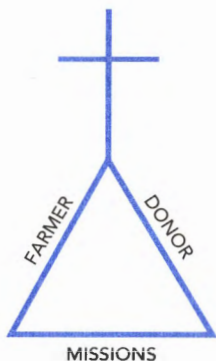

What is STEER, Inc.?

We are a 3-way partnership mission ministry committed to serving existing mission organizations. STEER, Inc. is interdenominational, evangelical, governed by a 15-member Board of Directors, and is a member of the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability.

As a Missionary, Why Should I Be Interested in STEER?

You can use the STEER program to help raise your support and help keep you on the mission field.

How Does STEER, Inc. Generate Funds for Missionary Support?

We have a MULTIPLIED GIVING impact program that involves three groups of people.

1. The DONOR provides investment capital by giving STEER a UNIT. This UNIT becomes a part of our MULTIPLIED GIVING fund and is used to invest in livestock and crop production. MULTIPLIED GIVING means that when the entire project is sold, the initial investment is deducted from the sale and later reinvested in other livestock and crop projects, always leaving the original UNIT intact.
2. The FARMER/RANCHER receives cash from this MULTIPLIED GIVING fund. He uses the cash to purchase livestock or cover the costs of crop production. A typical investment will produce a very high rate of return. This is because the FARMER/RANCHER donates his labor, feed, and the use of his land and machinery. The amount of the investment from the MULTIPLIED GIVING fund is covered by our insurance and depreciation fund.

3. The MISSION SOCIETY or MISSIONARY receives a large percent of the gain from the FARMER/RANCHER'S PROJECT. The remaining percentage covers the cost of insurance and depreciation as well as administrative expense incurred by STEER, Inc. in managing this missions program. Call the STEER office for current percentages.

How Do I Qualify to Receive Support?

The mission society you represent must be on STEER's membership list. To become a member, your mission must make application with STEER and be approved by our General Board of Directors. Contact the STEER office for more details about this process.

What Can I Do To Begin Receiving Support Through STEER?

- Step #1 – Contact farmers and ranchers you know who are interested in your ministry.
- Step #2 – Provide a brochure for the farmer/rancher showing how they can become involved in your financial support. The brochure is called "Creative Giving to World Missions for Farmers, Ranchers and Cattle Feeders." This is available upon request at printing costs. Take them through the program and suggest it as an easy way for them to support you.
- Step #3 – You may also show the farmer a DVD specially made by STEER for potential farmers which is available for purchase or can be viewed on STEER's website: www.steerinc.com.

Step #4 – Have the farmer/rancher sign an Agreement of Stewardship Form which we can supply, and send it to our office for processing. We require a bank reference which we verify before we invest any funds. There is a maximum investment limit for first time farmer/rancher participants.

Step #5 – Farmers and ranchers who are undecided or who desire more information should be referred to us. We keep all contacts confidential and make every reasonable effort to get them involved in your financial support.

How Long Before There is a Gain On the Investment?

This depends on the farmer/rancher and the type of project he has. For example, if the project is:

- Cow/calf – 7 to 12 months
- Feeder cattle – 6 to 12 months
- Crop – 5 to 9 months
- Dairy – Monthly

Your mission will receive a check for the gain on the sale within the first 10 days of the month following the date the sale was received by the STEER office. You will receive a copy of this sale from your mission.

Can I Count On the Farmer/Rancher's Continued Support?

Farmers and ranchers involved in yearly projects for your support should be treated like one of your regular monthly supporters. They become an important part of your support team. They will continue to support you as you keep them informed of your ministry. STEER, Inc. will invest funds for your support at the farmer's request.

Do I Need to Find UNIT Donors?

At the present time we have plenty of donor UNIT funds available so you do not need to be concerned about finding donor UNITS. But STEER, Inc. does reserve the right to ask you to help supply the donor UNITS should the need arise in the future after the printing of this brochure.
